

COOKIE POLICY - Comprehensive notice on the use of cookies

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that a web server generates and sends to a web browser. Web browsers store the cookies they receive and then send them back to the same websites on the user's next visit. Third-party cookies are cookies that are set by a website other than the one the user is visiting. Third-party cookies are created when a user visits a website that includes elements from other sites, such as third-party images, maps, sounds, specific links to web pages of other domains, and so on. Cookies are used for different purposes, such as performing computer authentication, session monitoring, storing information on specific configurations concerning users accessing the server, storing preferences. Information is provided below on the cookies placed through this website and on how to manage cookie preferences. Examples of other technologies

Localstorage

Localstorage is a technology used to optimise navigation and does not collect data on the user's preferences (for example, it stores a code that identifies the user's session after login, to avoid the user from typing username and password on each page when accessing restricted areas)

Tracking pixel

"Tracking code" or "tracking code" is a small portion of code that is released by some systems and then recalled into others to track some data about the user and his/her browsing sessions or email opening, in a manner that is totally transparent to the user. The data being tracked can vary from date and time of browsing, geographical position, type of device used for browsing, up to the more complex tracking pixels that can track how much money was spent for online orders as well as other useful information for the marketing departments of the companies using them.

Plugin

Plugins are software extensions that can be loaded on a program to improve its functionality. The most popular plugins are social media plugins, which allow the users to follow a social page or profile with one click, to express that they liked a web content with one click and to share it on their social media profile, etc.

Widget

A widget is an element of a graphical user interface that displays information or provides a specific way for a user to interact with the operating system or an application, thus making it easier for the user to interact with it. The most commonly used widgets are those of social networks, which allow users to easily access social networks in a separate browser window.

These services enable interaction with social networks, or other external platforms, directly from the pages of a site.
